EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

SELECTION OF A 'SEGA TIPIK' MUSIC INSTRUCTOR

The Le Morne Heritage Trust Fund was established under Act No. 10 of 2004.

The Le Morne Heritage Trust Fund invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from well-established and suitably experienced 'Sega Tipik' Music Instructors/'Sega Tipik' Music Firms to act as 'Sega Tipik' Music Instructor to the Le Morne Heritage Trust Fund in terms of **the eligibility criteria, scope of work and other terms and conditions** set out hereunder.

The Selected 'Sega Tipik' Instructor/ 'Sega Tipik' Music firm will be required to train the children as well as youngsters of Le Morne village in Sega Tipik so as to promote the preservation and dissemination of intangible cultural heritage in performing arts linked to the Le Morne village and be in accordance with the Scope of Work below.

The Fund proposes to hire the services of a 'Sega Tipik' Music Instructor on a contract basis for a period of ONE year from the date of award.

Eligibility criteria

- a) The Applicant should have, at least ten (10) years practice experience in the profession. Qualifications in musical training would be desirable and an added advantage. The Applicant should hold previous and varied experience of facilitating 'Sega Tipik' in the community. The Applicant should also master the use of locally made instruments such as 'ravanne', 'maravanne' and 'triangle'.
- b) The Applicants should have knowledge of the 'Sega Tipik Rythms' and be aware of its differentiation from Modern Sega.
- c) The Applicant should show proof of having acted as a 'Sega Tipik' Music Instructor/ 'Sega Tipik' Music firm in the organization of cultural events in Mauritius.

Scope of Work

1. To run creative 'Sega Tipik' Music sessions for children of Le Morne village aged 7-12 years once a week, either on Saturdays or Sundays, over a year, at Le Morne Heritage Trust Fund Site Office, Royal Road, Le Morne village.
 2. To develop and run a training calendar over 1 year to be proposed to the Le Morne Heritage Trust Fund for the students of the 'Sega Tipik'.

 3. To inspire and engage the children/youngsters through 'Sega Tipik.'
 4. To advise and adopt pedagogy through the use of musical teaching practices relevant to the student groups.

 5. To advise and implement effective as well as safe teaching methods.
 6. To advise and create a positive learning/teaching environment to the students of the 'Sega Tipik' Music classes.
 7. To inform the Le Morne Heritage Trust, parents and students of the artistic potential of the students in 'Sega Tipik' by forwarding monthly report to the Trust.
 8. To advise and assist the Le Morne Heritage Trust Fund in promoting self-development for the 'Sega Tipik' Music students.
 9. To impart the writing skills of 'Sega Tipik' Music to the students.
 10. To assist in the organization of workshops/events linked to the use of traditional instruments.
 11. To advise and develop artistic performances with the students for participation in events, most particularly for the Commemoration of the Anniversary Abolition of Slavery and for any other Cultural Event.

Other terms and conditions

- a) The Le Morne Heritage Trust Fund reserves the right to cancel/withdraw the invitation without assigning any reason thereof.

- b) The Le Morne Heritage Trust Fund reserves the right to accept/reject any proposal.
- c) The Le Morne Heritage Trust Fund reserves the right to discontinue the services of the appointed 'Sega Tipik' Music Instructor/ 'Sega Tipik' Music firm at any point of time on account of non-satisfactory performance by the latter.
- d) The 'Sega Tipik' Music Instructor/'Sega Tipik' Music firm has the right to discontinue the services with two months advance notice.
- e) There is no fee for participation in the EOI.
- f) No financial offer should be made at this stage.
